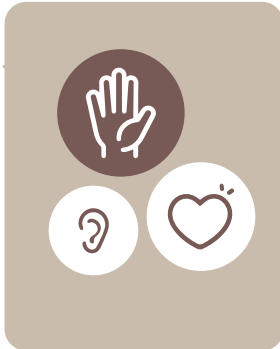


3rd trimester



Highlight: The sense of touch begins to develop very early in the womb, with the fetus sensing the warmth of the womb and the rhythm of the mother's heartbeat.

1st week after birth



Highlight: The moment of birth and the first week is an emotional transition period for the baby, and emotional development continues throughout the years

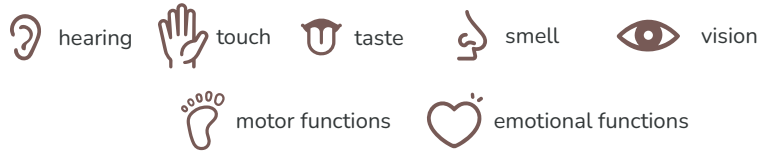
0–3 months



Highlight: Motor functions start developing swiftly during the first months as the baby begins interacting with their environment.

Making sense of the senses

What senses and brain functions are especially active during the first year of the baby's life



4–6 months



Highlight: Vision and eye coordination develop through the first year. The baby tracks objects and reaches out which improves hand-eye coordination.

7–9 months



Highlight: The baby expresses a wider range of emotions and starts to understand the concept of cause and effect.

10–12 months



The senses and brain functions mature to handle more complexity. Learning and memory functions become more active.
