## **3rd trimester**



Highlight: The sense of touch begins to develop very early in the womb, with the fetus sensing the warmth of the womb and the rhythm of the mother's heartbeat.



Highlight: The moment of birth and the first week is an emotional transition period for the baby, and emotional development continues throughout the years 0–3 months



Highlight: Motor functions start developing swiftly during the first months as the baby begins interacting with their environment.

## Making sense of the senses

What senses and brain functions are especially active during the first year of the baby's life



## 4–6 months



Highlight: Vision and eye coordination develop throught the first year. The baby tracks objects and reaches out which improves hand-eye coordination. 7–9 months



Highlight: The baby expresses a wider range of emotions and starts to understand the concept of cause and effect. 10-12 months



The senses and brain functions mature to handle more complexity. Learning and memory functions become more active.
